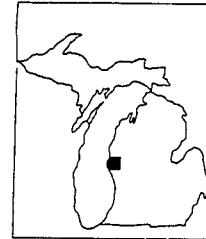

RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE  
OCEANA COUNTY SOIL EROSION ENFORCING AGENCY ACT 451  
NATURAL RESOURCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACTS OF 1994  
PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

Moved by Ms. Kolbe and seconded by Mr. Brown to amend the Oceana County Soil Erosion Enforcing Agency Act 451 Natural Resource and Environmental Protection Acts of 1994 Permit Fee Schedule as follows:

GARAGE, POLE BARN, ADDITION		\$100.00	\$190.00
LIMITED USE PERMIT (decks, septic)		\$ 75.00	\$143.00
EXTRACTION SITES (mining – same as commercial) Renewable on an annual basis for 4 additional years at a fee of ½ of the original fee			<b>An "After the Fact Permit Fee" will be assessed for any work started without a permit.</b>
ALL PERMITS EXPIRE 1 YEAR FROM DATE OF ISSUE, MAY BE RENEWED 1 TIME FOR 1 YEAR			
RENEWAL FEE: RESIDENTIAL ALL OTHERS – ½ ORIGINAL FEE		\$75.00	

**NORMAL TILLING, PLANTING AND HARVESTING OF AGRICULTURAL CROPS ARE EXEMPT.  
THE FEE FOR ALL OTHER AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES IS \$50 PER PERMIT AND \$100 for "AFTER  
THE FACT PERMITS"**


Non-residential projects MAY require engineered site plans with runoff calculations. If the enforcing agent feels that is necessary to have a professional engineer review the plans, all review costs will be paid for by the developer. A \$1,000 deposit will be required before the permit is issued and any unused portion of this deposit will be returned when the project is finalized.

**This fee schedule supersedes all other Soil Erosion Enforcing Agency fee schedules and takes effect November 1, 2015 with After the Fact Permit Fees for agricultural projects waived until February 1, 2016.**
