
SCHOOL AND SUMMER PARENTING TIME POLICY
COVID-19 PANDEMIC

The purpose of this School and Summer Parenting Time Policy is to prevent significant litigation and inconsistent results for the children who are affected by Governor Whitmer's Executive Order 2020-04 and 2020-35 suspending in-person K-12 instruction for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. To that end, the Oceana County Circuit Court Family Division shall interpret child support and parenting time provisions in judgments or orders as follows:

- (i) The 2019-2020 school year shall be deemed to continue through the original date the child's school would have ended under the school district's calendar;
- (ii) Uniform Child Support Orders shall be interpreted and enforced so that any child identified as a senior in high school in the 2019-2020 school year shall be deemed to have been attending high school on a full-time basis from and after March 10, 2020 (if they were attending full time prior to that date) through the end of the school year as identified by the graduation date as was originally scheduled by the school district. No other changes to the duration of support, as prescribed in MCL 552.605b, are intended by this clarification of the effect of the Executive Orders.
