

BUILDINGS, GROUNDS AND INSURANCE COMMITTEE MEETING

The Buildings, Grounds and Insurance Committee Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Brown on Thursday, January 9, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

Present: Mr. Brown, Ms. Meyette, Mr. Powers, Mr. Gustafson, Mr. Sebolt, and Mr. Walker. Absent: Mr. Byl.

Mr. Sobie, Oceana County Administrator; Ms. Anderson, Oceana County Clerk; and John Cavanagh, Oceana's Herald-Journal correspondent, were also present.

Moved by Mr. Sebolt and seconded by Mr. Gustafson to approve the minutes of the August 8, 2019 meeting as prepared.

Voice vote. Motion carried.

No public comments at this time.

Mr. Sobie provided a brief review of the Capital Improvement plan. There are a couple of carry-over projects left from 2019. The concrete pads at the transfer station still need to be completed. The canopy and step project near circuit court needs to be finished this year. The existing canopy should be able to be patched and repaired and the cost will be negligible. Additional items may be brought to the committee at a later date. Mr. Powers is concerned about the flooding on the lower level that has occurred over the past several years.

Mr. Sobie mentioned the concern regarding building space and how reducing clutter could help provide options for building redesign in the future that would maximize the existing space.

There being no further business to discuss, Chairperson Brown adjourned the Buildings, Grounds, and Insurance Committee meeting at 10:07 a.m.
