

PERSONNEL AND LICENSING AND INSPECTION SERVICES COMMITTEE

The Personnel and Licensing and Inspection Services Committee Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Christians on Thursday, January 28, 2021 at 9:07 a.m. via Zoom.

Roll was called. Present: Mr. Walker, Mr. Christians, Mr. Morse, Mr. Erickson, Mr. Beggs, Mr. Hardy, and Ms. Meyette.

Dr. Sobie, Oceana County Administrator; and Ms. Anderson, Oceana County Clerk, were also present.

Public participation was provided via audio/video conference using Zoom. The online meeting ID was 812 4664 3222.

There were no public comments on the agenda.

Dr. Sobie requested consideration of a resolution appointing a member to the Michigan Works! Workforce Development Board. He recommended Commissioner Meyette for this position.

Dr. Sobie requested consideration of a resolution approving an additional Probation Officer for the Courts. This would be in addition to the probation officer that is a shared position for adult and juvenile cases. Dr. Sobie explained that he met with Judge Lambrix and Judge Drake to discuss the request. Previously, the Courts shared a Probation Officer, however, due to legislation that has been implemented, both judges agreed that the shared position is no longer adequate.

Dr. Sobie requested consideration regarding Contract Negotiations with the Police Officers Association of Michigan (POAM).

Moved by Mr. Morse and seconded by Mr. Walker to enter into a closed session of the Personnel, Licensing and Inspection Services Committee.

Motion carried.
