Moved by Mr. Christians and seconded by Mr. Morse to approve the minutes from the February 11, 2021 Law and Safety Committee minutes as presented.

Mr. Sobie began discussion regarding a resolution to provide funding for the Alertus Emergency Mass Notification System. Undersheriff Schiller informed the board that the previous quote of \$18,345 is still valid. This is a one-time cost, with an annual fee of \$4,950.

Mr. Sobie facilitated discussion in regards to a resolution assessing a 911 Communications Device Surcharge.

Mr. Garry McKeen, Oceana County Parks & Recreation Commission, joins us from Little Point Sauble to let the board know that many homeowners in the area have created an *ad hoc* committee and feel that there is a lack of communication between emergency services and the Little Point Sauble community.

There being no further business to discuss, Chairperson Beggs adjourned the Law and Safety Committee meeting at 11:50 a.m.
