- 1. Review deposits are used for a 3rd party engineer to review Oceana County's adopted Stormwater Design Criteria effective October 1, 2004. A stormwater maintenance agreement must be signed and recorded before a soil erosion permit is issued.
- 2. Excavating/Construction activities found in violation of the ordinance will be charged twice the calculated fee.
- 3. Checks are made payable to the Oceana County Drain Commissioner. Cash is accepted. Credit cards are also accepted but additional fees apply.
- 4. Permits expire 1 year from the date of issue. May be renewed 1 time for 1 additional year. Renewal fee for residential is \$75. All others are 1/2 the original fee. Extraction sites renewable on an annual basis for 4 additional years at a 1/2 the original fee.
