- Black Lake P.M. Blough will attend the Parks and Recreation meeting on September 7, 2023. Mr. McKeen would like to get bids to remove the white pine at Black Lake.
- Cedar Point Park Mr. LundBorg provided the proposal for the park. Eight picnic tables will be put in the park. The new shelter is up, and the concrete floor should be installed shortly.
- Crystal Valley Park Mr. Chandler reported that the motion light was replaced. The Port
 a Jon that was tipped over has been taken care of. Mr. Chandler mentioned how much Lee
 Hyslop has helped out at Crystal Valley Park. Discussion ensued on the vandalism issues
 and updates.

- Doolittle Chairman McKeen reported that he blew the leaves off the floor and still needs to get the leaves off of the roof.
- Gale's Pond Mr. McKeen stated that Mr. Mikkelsen had worked on the Lutheran Bridge.
- Mill Pond Mr. Hiddema reported that the township has a tractor and will help remove the concrete chunk. He also made mention that new trash cans will be needed next year.
- Marshville Dam Mr. Wyns reported that eight contractors showed up to walk the dam to submit their bids possibly. Bids have to be submitted by August 14, 2023, with an April 1, 2024, construction start date. Discussion ensued on the dam and the construction project.
- Stony Lake Mr. McKeen reported that Mr. Mikkelsen didn't report anything new. There is some mowing that needs to be completed. Discussion ensued about the problems with the boat ramp.
