**MASON COUNTY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOND PROPOSAL**

Shall Mason County Central School District, Mason, Lake and Oceana Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-Two Million Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$22,375,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

partially remodeling school buildings, including remodeling for secure building entrances; equipping, re-equipping, furnishing, and refurbishing school buildings; acquiring, installing, equipping, and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; erecting, equipping, and furnishing a stadium restroom building; and developing, preparing, improving, and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities, and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2026 is 2.15 mills (\$2.15 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a -0- mills net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 1.87 mills (\$1.87 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
